## Cancellation scheme and bad weather insurance.

Bad weather is flowing wind or hurricane force and ice. In theory we would not be able to sail when it is above wind force 7 bft the choice is then to the skipper. Accidents and damage must of course be prevented. However, the Scallop can divert to the Randmeer or the River Vecht. This is possible because the mast is easy to iron and we can pass under a bridge that is impregnable for other ships .... As a result, the scallop is almost never blown away.
